# NEW YEAR CELEBRATION

Different countries celebrate New Year in different ways (5) e. The Chinese New Year is in the late January or February, the New Year in Israel is in autumn, and most Indian people celebrate New Year in spring. But in many parts of the world, 1 January is New Year's Day. This is the original date (6) c. We know the New Year starts on 1 of January in many countries, but it starts at different times because of international time zones; for example, the New Year in Australia starts ten hours earlier than in Britain.

People all over the world have parties on 31 of December, New Year's Eve. At midnight, they hold hands and sing Auld Lang Syne. The famous song, by the Scottish poet, Robert Burns, says we should remember the past (7) d. The Scottish have the best New Year celebrations in Britain, and New Year's Eve has a special name in Scotland, Hogmanay. People celebrate that holiday with bonfires and fireworks, and in some towns they burn an old boat to say (8) a. Many people in Scotland go and visit their friends after midnight, early on 1 January. They believe that the first person who enters the home on New Year's Day can bring good luck. This person should carry presents: (9) f, so the family is not hungry, poor or cold in the New Year. ### **Uniform- a type of special clothes**

Other occupations such as doctors and nurses wear uniforms so that people know who they are. Uniforms also protect their own clothes and are more hygienic.

Середина текста полностью вписывается в сюжет и соответствует заданному жанру и стилю. Рассказ передаёт чувства и эмоции автора и/или героев.
<b>8–7 баллов</b>	Коммуникативная задача выполнена. Текст рассказа соответствует заданным параметрам. Участник демонстрирует умение описывать имевшие место или вымышленные события. Сюжет понятен, но тривиален. Середина текста полностью вписывается в сюжет и соответствует заданному жанру и стилю. Рассказ передаёт чувства и эмоции автора и/или героев.
<b>6–5 баллов</b>	Коммуникативная задача в целом выполнена, однако имеются отдельные нарушения целостности содержания рассказа. Сюжет понятен, но не имеет динамики развития. Середина написанного рассказа не совсем сочетается с началом и концовкой. Рассказ не передаёт чувства и эмоции автора и/или героев. Рассказ соответствует заданному жанру и стилю.
<b>4–3 балла</b>	Коммуникативная задача выполнена частично. Содержание письменного текста не полностью соответствует заданным параметрам. Сюжет не всегда понятен, тривиален, не имеет динамики развития. Участник не владеет стратегиями описания событий и героев. Рассказ не полностью соответствует заданному жанру и стилю.
<b>2–1</b>	Предпринята попытка выполнения задания, но содержание текста <b>не</b> отвечает заданным параметрам. Рассказ не соответствует заданному жанру и стилю.
<b>0</b>	Коммуникативная задача не решена. Рассказ не получился, цель не достигнута.
